Dear Parent/Guardian,

With the beginning of the exam period approaching fast it is important that the coursework component of your son's Additional Science GCSE is completed as soon as possible.

With this in mind, all students in 11 West will be required to attend a compulsory coursework clinic next Tuesday (16th March). This session will begin immediately after school at 3:20pm and will finish by 5:30pm. Students who finish before this time will be free to leave earlier, and those who are unable to complete the task by this time will be required to attend a follow-up session on another date.

These sessions will take place in the following rooms:

- 11West 1 – Lab 2 (Mr Webber)
- 11 West 2 – Lab 7 (Mr Cheung)
- 11 West 3 – Lab 6 (Mr Galletly)

Students need to come to these sessions prepared to complete a Data Task. They will be provided with data but need to have revised the relevant topics to ensure they are able to provide a scientific background to their analyses and conclusions. 11W1 and 11W2 should revisit the work they have done on energy and motion (unit P3) while 11W3 should revisit the work they have done on respiration and exercise (unit B1).

It is essential that all students are present at these sessions (the small number of students in 11W1 who are studying towards a triple science award are **not** required to attend).
