INTRODUCTORY RITE

Father: In the name of the Father, Son and of the Holy Spirit.

All: Amen

Father: The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

All: And with your spirit

PENITENTIAL RITE

Father: My brothers and sisters, let us acknowledge our sins, and so prepare ourselves to celebrate the sacred mysteries.

The I Confess is said as part of the full Penitential Rite

**All: I confess to almighty God,
and to you, my brothers and sisters,
that I have greatly sinned,
in my thoughts and in my words,
in what I have done and in what I have failed to do,**

And, striking their chest, say:

**through my fault, through my fault,
through my most grievous fault;
therefore I ask blessed Mary ever-Virgin,
all the Angels and Saints,
and you, my brothers and sisters,
to pray for me to the Lord our God.**

Priest: ... Lord have mercy **All: Lord have mercy**

Priest: ... Christ have mercy **All: Christ have mercy**

Priest: ... Lord have mercy **All: Lord have mercy**

Father: May almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us our sins, and bring us to everlasting life.

All: Amen

GLORIA

The Gloria is said on Feast Days and Solemnities

**All: Glory to God in the highest,
and on earth peace to people of good will.
we praise you, we bless you,
we adore you, we glorify you,
we give you thanks for your great glory,
Lord God, heavenly King,
O God, almighty Father.**

**Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son,
Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father,
you take away the sins of the world,
have mercy on us;
you take away the sins of the world,
receive our prayer;
you are seated at the right hand of the Father,
have mercy on us.**

**For you alone are the Holy One,
You alone are the Lord,
You alone are the Most High,
Jesus Christ,
with the Holy Spirit,
in the glory of God the Father,
Amen**

All: Glory to you, Lord

At the end of the Gospel:

Father: The Gospel of the Lord

All: Praise to you Lord Jesus Christ

All Sit for The Homily.

THE CREED

On Sundays & Solemnities the Creed will be said

**I believe in one God,
the Father almighty,
maker of heaven and earth,
of all things visible and invisible.**

**I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ,
the Only Begotten Son of God,**

**born of the Father before all ages,
God from God, Light from Light,
True God from true God
begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father;
through him all things were made.
for us men and for our salvation
He came down from heaven,**

At the words "and became man" all bow.

**and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary,
and became man.
for our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate,
He suffered death and was buried,
and rose again on the third day
in accordance with the scriptures.
He ascended into heaven
and is seated at the right of the Father.
He will come again to judge the living and the dead
and his kingdom will have no end.**

**I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life,
who proceeds from the Father and the Son,
who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified,
who has spoken through the prophets.**

**I believe in one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church,
I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins
and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead
and the life of the world to come. Amen**

The Bidding Prayers:

(At the end of each prayer)

Reader: ... Lord, in your mercy

All: Hear our prayer.

THE LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST

The Preparation of the Gifts

Priest: Blessed are you, Lord, God of all creation, for through your goodness we have received the bread we offer to you:
Fruit of the earth and work of human hands,
it will become for us the bread of life.

All: Blessed be God for ever.

Priest: Blessed are you, Lord, God of all creation, for through your goodness we have received wine we offer you:
fruit of the vine and work of human hands,
it will become our spiritual drink.

All: Blessed be God for ever.

All Stand

Father: Pray Brothers and Sisters that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father.

**All: May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands
for the praise and glory of his name,
for our good and the good of all his holy Church.**

Then Father says a prayer over the offerings after which:

Father: The Lord be with you

All: And with your spirit

Father: Lift up your hearts

All: We lift them up to the Lord

Father: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God

All: It is right and just.

Then Father says a prayer to prepare for the Eucharistic Prayer after which:

All: **Holy, Holy, Holy Lord God of hosts.
Heaven and earth are full of your glory.
Hosanna in the highest.
Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.
Hosanna in the highest.**

All kneel

<i>EUCCHARISTIC PRAYER</i>

Father says the Eucharistic Prayer and Consecration

Father: The mystery of faith.
One of these acclamations is recited

**We proclaim your Death, O Lord,
and profess your Resurrection
until you come again**

Or

**When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup,
we proclaim your Death, O Lord,
until you come again**

Or

**Save us, Saviour of the world
for by your Cross and Resurrection
you have set us free**

Then Father continues the Eucharistic Prayer at the end of which:

Father: Through Him, and with Him, and in Him,
O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
all glory and honour is yours, for ever and ever.

All: Amen

All stand

THE COMMUNION RITE

Father: At the Saviour's command and formed by divine teaching,
we dare to say:

**All: Our Father who art in heaven,
hallowed be thy name.
Thy Kingdom come,
Thy will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread,
and forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against us,
and lead us not into temptation,
but deliver us from evil.**

Father: Deliver us, Lord, we pray, from every evil, graciously grant us
peace in our days, that, by the help of your mercy, we may be
always free from sin and safe from all distress, as we await the
blessed hope and the coming of our Saviour, Jesus Christ.

**All: For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours,
now and forever.**

Father: Lord Jesus Christ, who said to your apostles: Peace I leave you,
my peace I give you. Look not on our sins, but on the faith of your
Church, and graciously grant her peace and unity in accordance
with your will. Who live and reign for ever and ever.

All: Amen

Father: The Peace of the Lord be with you always.

All: And with your spirit.

Father: Let us offer each other a sign of peace

(Offer the sign of peace to others)

All: Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world:
Have mercy on us
Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world:
Have mercy on us
Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world:
Grant us peace.

All Kneel

Father: Behold the Lamb of God,
behold him who takes away the sins of the world.
Blessed are those who are called to the supper of the Lamb.

All: Lord I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof,
but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.

Holy Communion is then distributed.

All Stand

Father: Let us prayFor ever and ever

All: Amen

THE CONCLUDING RITES

Father: The Lord be with you

All: And also with your spirit

Father: May almighty God bless you, the Father, the Son
and the Holy Spirit.

All: Amen
