

Summer Newsletter SFX Centre 'We're off to London to visit the Queen!'

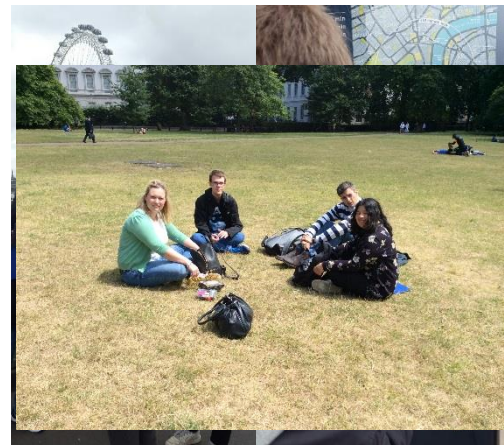
