I can understand most question words in French/Spanish.	I can identify many details from a longer text and answer in very short phrases in either language where required. I can translate short sentences from French/Spanish to English.	I attempt a short paragraph in the present tense, responding to compulsory bullet points. I can produce clear, simple opinions and recall some relevant topic vocabulary. I can translate a few simple sentences into French/Spanish with errors.
Securing	I can identify the overall message and different opinions in a longer, spoken passage. I can understand questions in English about the passage and respond in English as well.	I can take part in a short conversation, understanding and answering simple questions including simple opinions. Errors may impede my communication at times. I can describe what is in a photo using full, basic sentences. I can ask at least one question.	I can identify the overall messages, themes and different opinions in a longer text in French/Spanish. I can understand questions in English about the text and respond in English	I can write a few accurate sentences. I attempt to translate a few, simple sentences into French/Spanish, recalling the key vocabulary from memory.
Developing	I can understand the key message of spoken passages in one tense and answer multiple choice questions correctly.	I can understand and respond to simple questions in the target language. My message is conveyed despite errors. I can describe what is in a photo using full sentences.	I can understand the key messages in a written text in one tense and answer multiple choice correctly.	I can write very short, whole sentences in French/Spanish. I can include opinions. Frequent errors may occur.
