This will be made up from some of the work carried out in early Year 10, and all of the work carried out in the last term of Year 10 &amp; first term of Year 11. Students will have picked their own starting point and worked through the creative process towards an outcome. Students are marked over four Assessment Objectives, each equally weighted, and out of 96 in total.</p> <p><b>Component 2 (Externally Set Assignment (ESA))</b> is worth 40% of a student's grade. Not an exam in the traditional sense but ESA in which pupils receive question/starting point paper from the exam board. They will have between 10-12 weeks to explore, research and refine ideas before then complete a piece of work under timed conditions of 10 hours.</p>
