Prayers for Morning Worship – 18th to 22nd March

Theme for the week – Preparation for Easter

Question for Day 1:

When I examine my heart and thoughts, what do I need to let go off?

Bible quote for Day 1:

"I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh" Ezekiel 36: 36-37

Prayer for Day 1:

Lord, be the foundation on which I build my life. May I build no walls that keep anyone out but build your kingdom, together with all whom you give me as my brothers and sisters valuing all who are a part of my life. May I live in such a way that those who 'Trespass against me', who hurt me, may know my forgiveness and generosity, as I know yours. Surround me with your love and shield me from all harm. Amen

Question for Day 2:

How can I help others return to God?

Bible quote for Day 2:

"Yet even now", says the Lord, "Return to me with all your heart, With fasting, with weeping, and with mourning" Joel 2: 12

Prayer for Day 2:

We read in the gospel that Jesus was criticised for eating and celebrating with sinners. He told the story of the prodigal son and we hear that the father rejoiced and put on a feast when his lost son returned to him. In the same way, Father, you look out for us and rejoice and celebrate when we return to the fullness of life that Jesus offered. It is in and through our common humanity which Jesus himself shared that we are called to wholeness and holiness. Show us father how to be fully alive, rejoicing with those who rejoice and bringing comfort to those who are in sorrow. Amen

Question for Day 3: How can I approach God and ask for forgiveness?

Bible quote for Day 3: "Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him, and he will act." Psalm 37:5

Prayer for Day 3:

I confess to almighty God, and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do, through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault; therefore I ask blessed Mary ever-Virgin, all the Angels and Saints, and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord our God. Amen

Question for Day 4:

What do I need to forgive other people for?

Bible quote for Day 4:

Christ died for the godless. You could hardly find anyone ready to die even for someone upright. Christ died for us while we were still sinners. Romans 5:6-8

Prayer for Day 4:

Father, I ask you to help me to be generous when I think of the attitude and actions of others. Forgiving someone isn't an easy option, and I know that forgiveness isn't somehow pretending that something wrong hasn't happened. For what I have done wrong, forgive me father, to the extent that I am generous in forgiving those who have done wrong to me. Amen

Bible quote for Day 5:
