



FRIENDS OF CHALLONER LOTTO RULES

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Friends of Challoner Lotto is to raise funds to support Richard Challoner School in delivering the best possible education to its students

RULES

1. There will be a minimum of 100 members and a maximum of 600 members
2. For a cost of £10 per month (i.e. per draw) a Lotto member will be allocated one number between 1 and 600
3. Membership is agreed as a minimum of 12 months. Members can either leave or retain their exclusive membership after this period
4. A draw will be made every month and the winner will receive 25% of the monthly contributions
5. The draw will be made by the Headteacher, as witnessed by at least five members of the Challoner community. It will usually happen in school within seven days following the last day of the month; however some draws will happen outside of school depending on school holidays
6. The Friends of Challoner Lotto is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of Richard Challoner School. Any member of the Lotto must be aged 18 or over
7. Payment is by Direct Debit through GoCardless on 25th of each month (to ensure that the month's contribution is received before the draw). As part of joining up to the Lotto, the individual will be given a link which takes them to GoCardless's payment authorisation page. To set up the Direct Debit, and authorise us to take future payments automatically, the individual then clicks the link and provides bank details, using a secure checkout
8. A member's number will only be entered into a draw if their subscription is up to date
9. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list
10. Winners must provide their bank details to the school via email, and on receipt of this Friends of Challoner will endeavour to make payment by bank transfer within seven days
11. The name and number of each month's winner will be posted on the School website
12. The Lotto is run by Friends of Challoner. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Friends of Challoner Committee is final
13. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the Friends of Challoner Lotto if their subscription remains unpaid for a period of one month
14. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Friends of Challoner funds after 6 months
