Computer Science FAQs

What are the requirements to join the course?

Specific Entry Requirement:

- GCSE Grade 6 or above in Computer Science
- GCSE Grade 5 or above in Mathematics and English Language
- Students who do not have a GCSE in Computer Science would need a meeting with the Subject Leader.

What if I do not have a GCSE in Computer Science?

You may be given an interview with the Leader of Computer Science depending on your circumstances to evaluate and show your programming skills.

What if I do not meet the entry criteria to join the A-Level?

Unfortunately, you will not be able to do the CS A-Level course.
