Their stated aim is to use international best practice to raise standards in apprenticeships and technical education so more young people and employers succeed. Some of their recent initiatives include:

'Spotlight on Green Jobs' Spotlight on Green Jobs - WorldSkills UK, an online insight event held on 9-10 March where they brought together a variety of employers and apprentices to inspire young people from all walks of life to consider the vocational pathways which will lead them to green careers. Sessions were broken down into 30-minute slots to fit into school timetables and contain live Q&As, videos and expert career advice. Examples of the topics explored included:

- -The role of STEM in building a green economy
- -Practical examples of how to use IT to reduce carbon footprint
- -Emerging technologies to support a greener future

'Skills Competitions' Find And Enter A National Skills Competition | WorldSkills UK designed by industry experts, to assess student's knowledge, practical skills, and employability attributes against set criteria in a competitive timed-environment. Competitions are held in stages throughout the year and are designed to contribute to participants' personal and professional growth and preparation for employment. As well as building on their technical skill set, they aim to help competitors become well-rounded individuals by evolving their professional and personal skills throughout the process. They offer these competitions across multiple industries and professions including construction & infrastructure, Hospitality, Digital/Creative and several others.

FreeFormers This is an interactive video of someone on a work experience placement, at a Technology company You don't need to be interested in Technology to do this virtual work experience. It gives you a great idea of what it would be like to carry out a work experience placement in a real company to give you a 'feel' for going into a new company and meeting new people. You will need to follow the link above and register an account to access the video.

World of Work This is a great variation of work experience which explores a variety of types of work and also employability skills. You don't need to register. You must click on the tab which says Monday and complete the 4 lessons on that. You must then choose at least 1 of the other days (for example Thursday) and complete the 4 lessons You don't register on this so you must let your careers teacher know if you choose this option and which days you will be working through – they will then be able to access the certificate.

InsideSherpa

An excellent website which offers virtual work experience placements from a range of companies, from banking to careers in tech. Most options last up to six hours and involve tutorials, videos and activities.

InvestIn (paid)

Aimed at students between 14 and 18 years old, InvestIn offers an impressive array of virtual work placements involving real life work and contact with professionals. This is a paid service, and placements range from one day to one week. Prices start from £90.

Oak National Academy (aimed at students in Year 10)

A virtual 'work experience week' with access to videos, lessons and insights into a range of different industries and careers.

Speakers4Schools

Recently launched, Speakers4schools aims to provide a level playing field by connecting young people to high quality virtual work placements. Register to stay up to date with their latest developments.

Youth Opportunities
